

# 2020 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE RESULTS

Dear St Anne's Community

I am delighted to present to you a summary of our 2020 IEB matric results. I am sure that you will join me in congratulating the Class of 2020 on these excellent results.

We had 85 candidates sit for the IEB National Senior Certificate examinations last year. All 85 girls achieved a Bachelor Degree Certificate pass for university admission. This in itself is a remarkable achievement considering the challenges the girls needed to overcome during 2020.

- There were 276 individual Level 7 (A symbol) scores including 54 of 90% or more
- 82 girls (97 %) achieved a Level 7 in at least one subject
- 62 girls (73 %) achieved a Level 7 in two or more subjects
- 77% of the individual marks achieved across all subjects are Levels 6 or 7
- An average of 3,25 distinctions per pupil was achieved which is particularly noteworthy as girls at St Anne's take only the 7 required subjects in keeping with our holistic education philosophy
- Congratulations to Sarah Church on her inclusion in the IEB list of candidates for **Outstanding Achievement** (achieved within the top 5% in 6 or more Subjects and achieved a rating level of 7 in Life Orientation)

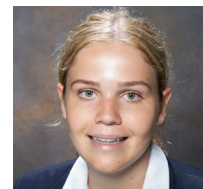
