Dear St Anne's Community

I am delighted to present a summary of our 2021 IEB matric results. I am sure that you will join me in congratulating the Class of 2021 on these excellent results.

We had 93 candidates sit for the IEB National Senior Certificate examinations last year. All 93 girls achieved a Bachelor Degree Certificate pass for university admission.

- There were 330 individual Level 7 (A symbol) scores including 73 of 90% or more
- 89 girls (96%) achieved a Level 7 in at least one subject
- 82 girls (88%) achieved a Level 7 in two or more subjects
- 84% of the individual marks achieved across all subjects are Levels 6 or 7 (A symbol or B symbol)
- An average of 3,55 distinctions per pupil was achieved which is particularly noteworthy as girls at St Anne's take only the 7 required subjects in keeping with our holistic education philosophy
- A total of 22 individual subject results appear in the IEB list of **Top 1% of candidates per subject** – see the full list below
- Lilitha Nkuhlu is included in the IEB list of candidates for **Outstanding Achievement** (achieved within the top 5% in six or more subjects and achieved a rating level of 7 in Life Orientation)
- Rosalie Brouckaert and Erin Douglas are included in the IEB list of candidates for **Commendable Achievements** (achieved within the top 5% in five or more subjects and achieved a rating level of 7 in Life Orientation)
- Congratulations to Esmé Thornhill-Davis on the superb achievement of 100% in Visual Arts
